


Choose from one of our three measuring techniques to get your ring size.

The Surprise Test

FIND: Find a ring that your sweetheart currently wears on the same finger as the new ring.

MEASURE: Place the ring on top of each circle. Find one that shows the entire black line circle on the INSIDE of the ring with no extra space showing.

CHECK: Double check for accuracy.

The Paper Test

CUT: Carefully cut out the paper ring sizer below and create a slit on the line labeled "your size"

MEASURE: Slip the pointed end through the slit and place around your finger, pulling the pointed end until it fits snug. The number line located at the "your size" slit is your size.

CHECK: Double check for accuracy.



The String Test

CUT: A small piece of string, thread, ribbon with a simiar width to your desired ring.

MEASURE: Wrap is around your finger for a snug (but not tight) fit. Compare it with our "surprise test" chart to determine your size. For best results, have someone help you measure.

CHECK: Double check for accuracy.

RING SIZING GUIDE:

While this guide may be close enough to get your design process started, it may not be 100% accurate.
